Wilderness Bamboo Park – Self-Guided Tour. 800 Upper Kingston Road, Prattville. The U.S. military once used the bamboo forest inside the Wilderness Park during the Vietnam era. It is open from dawn to dusk.

ACMGA Demonstration Garden – Self-Guided Tour. 254 Doster Street, Prattville. This garden site is leased from the City of Prattville. All produce grown here is donated to Autauga Interfaith Community Center (AICC). It is open during daylight hours.

ACMGA Prattvillage Garden – Self-Guided Tour. 143 First Street, Prattville. The garden is privately owned and leased by ACMGA. The circa 1840's flower and herb gardens surround a historic chapel. It is open during daylight hours.

Demonstration at Prattvillage Garden – Jane McCarthy, Horticulturist and Master Gardener, will demonstrate the use of natural elements in the garden. There is no charge for the class and it is limited to 25 participants.
